Satisfactory Progress Policy - Additional Requirements for PhD Students

- **Current policy states:**
 - **Failure to meet expectations listed above can result in a loss of funding commitments.**
- The expectations are listed out, but there are no details about when and specifically why this loss of funding might happen

Proposed Updates

We would like to update this policy to state:

- ***Failure to meet the expectations specified above will result in the loss of department-supported funding (teaching assistantship and fellowship) and faculty-supported RA funding, for students with Academic Probation status"***
- Removed "may result in loss of RA funding" as previously proposed after meeting with Profs Anantram, Hauck, and Yazdan-Shahmorad

If approved, we will then update our Academic Warning and Probation letters to support this. Right now we don't have any language to indicate that students might lose funding in the letters even though we do in our policy.
